- Display shipments for PACS (Picture Archive Communications Systems) in the medical area will be the fastest growing application for specialty monitors. Unit shipments are expected to rise by a 20.8% compound annual growth rate by 2010.
- The fastest growing segment on a unit basis will be graphic arts which are predicted to see shipments increase 3.3 million in 2010 from 1.7 million in 2005.

• The specialty markets are demonstrating a faster shift from CRT to LCD due to a lower price delta between the two technologies.
